- October 12, 2016 HVBS meeting at the Hoffman House in Kingston. As Surveyor turned into Green Street he noted Ramrod turning into the restaurant parking lot. With a large Sysco tractor-trailer occupying the right-hand side of the lot Surveyor carefully pulled into a space next to Ramrod who occupied one of the 'handicap' parking spots. Entering the premises we again found Hostess Ginny Bradley policing the patio tables. Entering the building, we were greeted by Host Pat at the bar, bartender Pat behind the bar and HVBS Official Waitress Lorayne proceeding ahead of us to the table with menus.
- 2- The first order of business was ordering drinks. Ramrod opted for a Jack Daniels Old Fashioned, Surveyor his usual orange vodka.
