October 25, 2017 – 6th Meeting of the year.

- 1. With HVBS member Surveyor presently in Florida, Gladiator drove Associate Member Shirley to PC Wiz's home. Designated driver PC Wiz, with Gladiator, then proceeded to our Hoffman House destination. The partly cloudy day turned completely cloudy. We turned into Green Street, noting the 'for sale' sign still in evidence. The restaurant was receiving a delivery with the large truck squarely centered on the entrance path, thus blocking both handicapped spots we usually occupy. The big TV news is President Trump's feud with his Republican 'establishment' opponents Senator Bob Corker (R-TN) and Senator Jeff Flake (R-AR).
